Caliban's association with "darkness and dirt" is the opposite of Miranda's association with purity and light and the actual lighting plays a large role in this "dark exhibition," where the art is lit with spotlights and projections (on the bare portions of the gallery walls) that are a part of the actual production and the fine art exhibition.
